
APA Referencing

Guides to cite three main types of source are given below. Follow these guides as closely as possible. See the APA guide for further examples. These tables are **guides only** – please do not include tables in your reference list!

Bibliu Book

Surname(s),	Initials.,	(Year).	Title of Book	Edition (If greater than first).	Publisher	URL.

Webpage

Surname(s)/name of website,	INITIALS.,	(Year).	Title of Webpage	Website name	URL

Online Journal Article

Surname(s)	INITIALS.,	(Year).	Title of Article.	Title of Journal	<i>Volume</i> (Issue),	Page numbers	URL
